Divine Mercy Sunday

Divine Mercy Sunday came through a series of revelations from Jesus to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s. Jesus called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Pope St. John Paul II named it Divine Mercy Sunday at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000. Today the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened; Jesus' mercy is so great that no mind, be it man or angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (Diary, 699). All souls will have eternal life. Some will go to eternal damnation (Hell). Others will enter Purgatory where the purification process is finished (and enter heaven eventually). The most fortunate will go directly to Heaven. To receive these graces, go to Confession any time before or on Divine Mercy Sunday. Be in a state of grace for the Divine Mercy Sunday Mass. Communion can only be received at the Saturday evening Vigil Mass or on Divine Mercy Sunday. After receiving Holy Communion, return to your seat and pray: Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, have mercy on me a poor sinner. I have gone to Confession and received Holy Communion according to your instructions given to St. Faustina. Please grant me the grace of forgiveness of sins and punishments. Jesus, I trust in you! Take a moment to bring any additional issues and needs to the Lord as it will be a year before the "floodgate of graces" are opened to this degree again. Thank God for the graces He has granted.

After receiving His Divine Mercy, show your gratitude by practicing the "deeds of mercy" Jesus gave: "I am giving you three ways of exercising mercy toward your neighbor: the first by deed, the second by word [kind/encouraging], the third by prayer. In these three degrees is contained the fullness of mercy, and it is an unquestionable proof of love for Me. By this means a soul glorifies and pays reverence to My mercy" (Diary, 742). The Chaplet of Divine Mercy promises: "Whoever will recite it, they will receive great mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy" (Diary, 687). "At the hour of their death, I defend every soul that will say this Chaplet as I do my own glory. When this Chaplet is said by the bedside of a dying person, God's anger is placated, and His unfathomable mercy envelops the soul" (Diary, 811). Will you share His mercy with others?

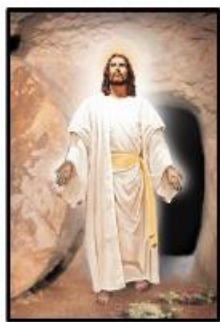
